

The project iHeal, co-funded by Erasmus+ KA2 Strategic Partnerships in the field of adult education, aims to create a training programme to facilitate elderly people's access to electronic health services.

The project partners are currently working for the development of an inclusive, interactive and user-friendly digital platform to equip and improve digital health literacy for European citizens aged 50+.

Despite the temporary suspension of all the foreseen face-to-face activities due to the Covid-19 emergency, the partner organizations are finalizing the training platform, being aware that the current situation has strongly highlighted the growing role of digital technologies in gathering information and taking care of citizens' health.


103: iHeal Interactive Web platform, learning environment, applications and digital learning tools

Intellectual Output 3 (IO3) consists of the iHeal online platform and the iHeal mobile application. These tools support the delivery of all online learning components and the online interactive tools of the project.

iHeal Digital Platform/Website: A professionally designed platform developed by the Center for Social Innovation makes all project products widely available and facilitates the exchange of good practice in the area, providing target groups and stakeholders with access to other relevant resources. The platform, provides all background information related to the project progress, the deliverables, the partners and the funding agency. It also provides sharing resources, discussions, and social networking applications. This is developed on cutting-edge, open-source technology, which allows the use of the latest technological tools and a user-friendly environment.

iHeal Online Learning Environment and online tools development: The online learning environment has been officially launched on the 1st May 2020 and is created using a Learning Management System (LMS) and presents an effective virtual learning environment where users are able to find the online modules, participate in learning activities, mini games and use assessment tools to evaluate their performance. The online Learning Environment also supports the digital resources data base, multimedia content and the Adaptation Toolkit (IO5) parts of which concern the users' guide for the platform. A variety of online interactive tools are developed in order to facilitate the learning process and to promote social networking and information sharing among target groups, providers and stakeholders. Such tools are the online learning environment including the modules, social networking applications, peer communication and collaboration, interactive activities, information sharing, health management systems in order to create an online community of target groups, providers and stakeholders. The online educational and collaborative tools will be integrated in the online platform of the project and be available to all registered users.

iHeal Mobile Application: Part of the digital tools of the project will be the development of an application for mobile platforms (i.e. Android, iOS, Windows), which is scheduled to be released in the summer of 2020. In an era where the multidimensional usage of smartphones is massive, an innovative information and communication application will increase the penetration of the project outcomes to the wider public and in greater number of target groups' members. The mobile application will be developed based on the online platform.

PROJECT PARTNERSHIP

3rd Transnational Project Meeting by ASTERES

On 5th and 6th December 2019 the project partners gathered in Senigallia, Italy, for the 3rd Transnational Project Meeting.

The consortium discussed the structure and technical features of the training platform, and analysed the contents of the 8 educational modules that it will be composed of. Upon attendance of the online training course, learners will be able to:

- Use social media and digital tools for health-related purposes
- Evaluate the reliability of website and online information
- · Foster their digital health literacy and became effective digital patients
- · Manage their health data
- · Navigate the digital services available in their country

Using a peer review approach, the partners refined the learning materials, making sure they are suitable for the specific project target groups, in compliance with the adult education principles.

They include multimedia materials, such as videos, audios and pictures, and contain links for more in-depth information on the topics covered. The training course will be available in English, German, Greek, Italian, Portuguese and Turkish. Each version will contain country-specific information, related for instance to online booking services, sanitary Institutions or mobile-phone applications.

Furthermore the partners planned the organization of a transnational training activity (LTT), in order to present the training materials and platform to professionals and stakeholders, with the aim of making it available at a large audience of multiplier institutions.

The LTT was supposed to take place in Çanakkale, Turkey, in May 2020, but has been postponed until a later date due to the Covid-19 emergency.
