# Conceptual Framework for Training Chefs, Kitchen Staff & Food Handlers

Partners conducted extended Desk Research on the existing training opportunities for food handlers across Europe. We have identified 1245 formal, informal and non-formal education training programmes with the majority of them being offered in the UK, Greece, and Hungary. e-SAFE's field research included a survey questionnaire that was answered by 211 people from 22 countries across the EU and internationally. The survey's results were the base for the elaboration of e-SAFE's Training Curriculum Methodology.

## Training Curriculum Methodology

Based on the results of their Research, e-SAFE's team has developed an innovative Methodology Document to plan and adapt the project's training course to the current needs of food handlers. The partners have designed 7 training modules.



# Development of e-SAFE's Training Package

Partners have started working bilaterally on the Training Course's 7 modules that will be tested during the Blended mobility training event that will take place in Lucca, Italy in spring 2023. The training topics derive from the project's initial Desk and Field Research and will focus on health and safety basics, emergency sanitary crisis management, nutrients, food allergies, mycotoxins, aflatoxins, trans fatty acids, and chemical hazards. The aim of this training package is to combine theoretical and practical activities to further develop the food handlers' knowledge and to help them improve their daily practices.



The project's e-Learning platform will contain the online version of e-SAFE's training package and will be piloted during the Short-term joint staff training event that will take place in Vienna, Austria in November 2022. The platform will be finalized in spring 2023 and will be available in all project languages.

### **Partner Meetings**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, e-SAFE's first two Transnational Partner Meetings have been held online. Partners are currently planning the project's 3rd Transnational Partner Meeting in physical presence in Kaunas, Lithuania and continue to meet virtually on a monthly basis to support each other and monitor the overall progress of their ongoing tasks.
