Presentation of UNIHEAL+

UNIHEAL+ is an ERASMUS+ KA2 project approved by the Spanish national Agency with an implementation period of 24 months, between 01/02/2022 - 31/01/2024.

The project is being conducted by a consortium of (7) partners from (5) European countries: Spain, Cyprus, Greece, Lithuania and Romania.

The project intends to achieve 4 main results:

1. **UNIHEAL+ Framework Courses – a completed approach (PR1)**
2. **The Adaptation and Training Guide for UNIHEAL+ Educators (PR2)**
3. **eLearning Resources & Digital Tools (PR3)**
4. **UNIHEAL+ Skills Assessment, Validation and Recognition Content & Tools (PR4)**

UNIHEAL+ addresses the re-skilling and upskilling in health professionals by:

- designing a specific VET curriculum
- constructing WELL STEPPED UNITS OF TRAINING, educational materials, work-based scenarios, guides for the VET educators as well Health services providers
- equipping health professionals to better deliver their jobs, by training them in digital health services, thus improving their use of computational technologies, smart devices, communication media, etc.

TARGET GROUPS ADDRESSED:

- The frontline health sector staff/professionals (e.g., nurses, doctors, pharmacists, physicians, dentists, midwives, etc.)
- The VET educators who undertake the role and tasks of effectively addressing the training of health professionals

Kick-off-Meeting - 24th of March 2022 online



The KoM was held online on the **24th of March 2022**.

After a round presentation, the leader gave an overall presentation of the UNIHEAL+

Project, summarizing the overall tasks that have to be developed and disseminated throughout the project. Also, a discussion was made about the proper technology regarding the digital tools of the project.

UNIHEAL+ Collated research report

The collated research report was implemented from March to July 2022.

There were 167 participants to the survey and 29 to the focus groups, so that the total number of participants reached at this research phase is 196.

All the participants from the survey agreed on the importance of all competence units:

CU1: Framework skills and aptitudes for digital communication

CU2: Computer literacy, data analysis, data protection programs

CU3: eHealth& mHealth context and content

CU4: Medical devices compatibility

CU5: Mobile applications, cloud storage, internet usability- functionality

CU6: Universal digital health coverage

The research reassured what was already anticipated at the preparation of the proposal:

- **Media to use: learning platforms, OER and audio and video files.**
- **The methods reflecting higher scores are everyday life problems and group work followed by frontal instruction and stories and case studies.**
- **Each competence unit will last 10 hours.**

The partners are now working on the development of the curriculum adapting the 6 competence units to the results of the research.
