## Piloting Sessions & Multiplier Events

ITC implemented the piloting on the 31st of October 2023 at ADEMA University School, in Spain, with 26 participants. Moreover ITC implemented the multiplier event on the 12th of January 2024, with 20 participants, in the frame of the BNI expand networking event where 20 professionals expressed their interest in the UNIHEAL+ training platform and app and which is most important its potential of sustainability.


The piloting session held by **Fundación Ayesa** took place on October 27th 2023 in Ayesa's Offices (Sevilla), with an estimated duration of 2 hours. It was implemented face-to-face and received a total of (62) participants from which, (26) are health professionals from social organizations, and (36) are students enrolled in a health-related vocational training programme in Higher Education School "IES Sotero Hernández".

Furthermore, **Fundación Ayesa** implemented its multiplier event on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023 in Ayesa's Offices and received a total of 62 health sector related participants of which (36) belong to a health-related vocational training programme, and (26) were health professionals from social organizations.

The pilot training session in Lithuania, from **Xwhy**, was organized online from the 16th till the 30th of November 2023. It consisted of a short introduction to the project, keynote presentations about digital communication and artificial intelligence, UNIHEAL+ learning platform presentation and demonstration, training evaluation, discussion and Q&A. The pilot training was implemented with 4 trainers and 20 healthcare-professionals-to-be from Vilnius Service Business Vocational Training Centre.

The multiplier event in Lithuania was organized face-to-face on the 12th of December 2023 at Medardas Čobotas University of the Third Age in Vilnius. It was attended by 29 participants who were educators working in the fields of healthcare and adult education, as well as their students' attending classes and courses. Most of the students (adult learners) came from the Faculty of Healthy Lifestyle (as well as the Faculty of Psychology) of Medardas Čobotas University of the Third Age, as well as from other organizations like The Critical, research and design agency, and Vilnius College of Design.

The piloting activities of the UNIHEAL+ project in Cyprus, from the **Center of Social Innovation-CSI** took place in different settings and dates. This happened to achieve a greater reach of participants. Particularly, three (3) main piloting activities were implemented each having a time duration of around 2,5-3 hours. All three activities had a total of 14 participants that all were students from different healthcare related departments.

More specifically the activities were:

1. Erasmus Days at the University of Nicosia on 11th of October 2023 (5 students participated in the piloting from the departments of Nursing and Sports Science)
2. Visit at the Laboratory of Embryology and Stem Cells at the University of Cyprus on the 3rd of November 2023 (5 students participated in the piloting from the Biology department)
3. Visit at the Susini College in Nicosia on the 27th of November 2023 (4 students participated from the Aesthetics and Beauty course of the college)
- Other registrations to the platform were from users that were informed for the piloting activities through an email invitation.

As regards the Multiplier Event, a total of 35 people participated in the UNIHEAL+ Multiplier Event organised by the **Center of Social Innovation-CSI** and supported by the Nursing Department of Frederick University. The majority of participants were students currently pursuing studies in the Nursing Department, while two members from the department's teaching faculty also took part. Additionally, attendees encompassed laboratory researchers from the University of Cyprus, a representative from the healthcare industry, and a board member from the Cyprus Resuscitation Council.

The face-to-face piloting session took place on the 18th of December 2023, in Bucharest, Romania. The team of **GRIPEN EUROPE** gave emphasis on presenting briefly the project (context and objectives), the project results (PRs) and the digital platform- modules. The 22 participants came from a variety of scientific background thus students, health professionals and project managers.

XENIOS POLIS organised a face-to-face piloting session in Athens/Greece on the 21st of December 2023, in which 21 participants met the project' idea and its objectives, exchanged ideas and shared suggestions on the digital health. The piloting addressed to students between 17-19 years old who join courses and trainings both to digital skills and master courses on digital health specialisation.

The presentation of the UNIHEAL+ project and the courses included, covered approximately 1 and a half hour. The piloting included the following topics: 1. General brief introduction on the UNIHEAL+ project (objectives, project results, pillar outcomes from the research) 2. Background and experience of the participants on the digital health and expectations from the elearning platform 3. Presentation of the platform, registrations, evaluation and discussion
